

## SUMMARY OF THE RULES FOR EMH MEMBERS



### **National Member**

- a. One per state.
- b. Single vote in General Assembly.
- c. 100% contribution fee.
- d. Can be appointed in Excom and chairman in councils.
- e. Can participate in Working Group and councils.
- f. Refund of travel and hotel expenses for attending councils.

### **Regional Member**

- a. One per geographical and political autonomous region in a state, to decide upon by Working Group, and as long as there is no national member. The first regional member is treated as a national member.
- b. One vote for all regional members of a state in General Assembly.
- c. Regional members pay each 2/3 of a national membership.
- d. Can be appointed in Excom and chairman in councils if all regional members of that state support this.
- e. Can participate in Working Group and councils.
- f. Refund of travel and hotel expenses for attending councils for maximum one representative of all regional members of a state.

### **Associate Member**

- a. Any organisation which owns, operates or represents traditional vessels.
- b. One vote for all associated members in General Assembly.
- c. 10% contribution fee.
- d. Cannot be appointed in Excom or as chairman of councils.
- e. Can participate in Working Group and councils.
- f. Refund of travel and hotel expenses for attending councils for maximum one representative of all associated members.

### **Advisory Member**

- a. Museums or centres which are involved with European traditional vessels.
- b. One vote for all advisory members in General Assembly.
- c. 10% contribution fee.
- d. Cannot be appointed in Excom or as chairman of councils.
- e. Can participate in Working Group and councils.
- f. Refund of travel and hotel expenses for attending councils for maximum one representative of all advisory members.

**Councils and Groups** may be formed on proposal of the Excom and agreed by the Working Group. Councils and groups prepare the policy for the Excom and communicate their work with Excom only. Councils and Groups can be attended by representatives of all members.
